WHAT: **Cruisin' For Vets**, an annual custom car, hotrod, and motorcycle show benefiting veterans and youth of Orange County. This Car Show will last approximately six hours. It will contain cars and motorcycles that compete for trophies as well as vehicles that are just for show. A blood drive is conducted via Boy Scout Troop 623. Additional services will be conducted by the Veterans Administration for local veterans.

WHEN: Saturday, September 13, 2008; 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

WHERE: Foothill Ranch Chevrolet in Foothill Ranch California.

WHY: To raise funds and awareness for Saddleback Valley American Legion programs. These funds will be used in direct support of veteran programs such as health awareness, burial ceremonies, financial aid, and benefits awareness. Youth and community programs that benefit are programs that educate elementary grade students on veterans, Boys State, Boy Scouts, Law and Order, and US Flag retirement.

Cruisin' for Vets 2008 – Vendor Agreement

Agreement: Upon execution by both parties, this Agreement shall constitute a binding agreement between Saddleback Valley American Legion Post 862 and its related entities and _____ (“Vendor”), whereby Post 862 agrees to rent vendor space to Vendor at the Cruisin' For Vets event on September 13, 2008, at Foothill Ranch Chevrolet in Foothill Ranch, CA, pursuant to the terms contained herein. Any changes or additions to this Agreement must be in writing and executed by both Post 862 and Vendor to be valid.

Space Allocation: Vendor understands that vendor space allocation shall be at the sole discretion of Post 862. Vendor spaces are available on a first come first serve basis. Post 862 will make every reasonable attempt to grant requests for assignment of specific vendor location whenever possible. Order of preference is assigned based on the date Post 862 receives a completed Vendor Booth Application along with the agreed upon fee.

Payment of fees: Confirmation of vendor space is subject to receipt by Post 862 of a completed Vendor Agreement accompanied by payment of all space fees. No refunds will be issued for any reason after September 8, 2008; this is a rain or shine event.

Permits and Insurance: Vendor shall comply with all the California State Laws and local ordinances regarding the sale of merchandise and/or food. Vendor agrees to obtain, at its sole expense, any sales, health or other permits that may be required for participation in Cruisin' For Vets. Copies of all applicable permits/licenses and proof of Insurance must be submitted to Post 862 on or before **September 8, 2008**.

Food Vendors: Food vendors must supply copies of completed/issued Health Permits to Post 862 ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 8, 2008. Food vendors are also required to list “Post 862” AND “Foothill Ranch Chevrolet,” as additional insured (for the one-day period of the event) on their policy of insurance. A copy of the insurance must be received by Post 862 on or BEFORE September 1, 2008. Failure to comply with these requirements will subject Vendor to loss of its vendor space and space fees, at Post 862's sole discretion.

Taxes: Vendor agrees to be responsible for collecting and distributing to the proper agency (ies) any applicable state/local taxes.

Release: Vendor agrees to release, indemnify and hold harmless The American Legion, Saddleback Valley American Legion Post 862, Foothill Ranch Chevrolet, and The City of Foothill Ranch/Lake Forest, and their respective related entities and representatives including, but not limited to, their officers, agents, employees, contractors, committee members, volunteers, guests, patrons and/or staff from any and all liability, injury or damage which may result from acts, omissions or negligence of any person or entity during Vendor's participation in Cruisin' For Vets at Foothill Ranch Chevrolet, on September 13, 2008. This release shall include, but not limited to, any injury or damages that may stem from personal injury or loss of life, loss of property, theft, damage by fire, or any other causes that might be suffered by Vendor, its agents, officers, employees, contractors, invitees, patrons or guests. Vendor hereby confirms and acknowledges that it holds current and adequate liability insurance.

Reservation of Rights: Post 862 reserves the right to prohibit the sale and/or display of any products deemed by the Cruisin' For Vets Committee to be unsuitable. No drug paraphernalia and/or firearms may be displayed or sold. No adult orientated material, behavior, apparel or products may be exhibited, displayed modeled or sold. If it's illegal, it may not be displayed or sold. Failure to comply with this agreement will be grounds for immediate removal, without refund, of the Vendor, its merchandise, directors/officers, employees, sales representatives, and guests from the event grounds. Post 862 maintains its exclusive right to event promotional items (t-shirts, pins, photos, etc.) Those items may not be reproduced or marketed in any form or manner without the express, written approval of the Cruisin' For Vets 2008 Co-chairs and Post 862 Executive Staff.
